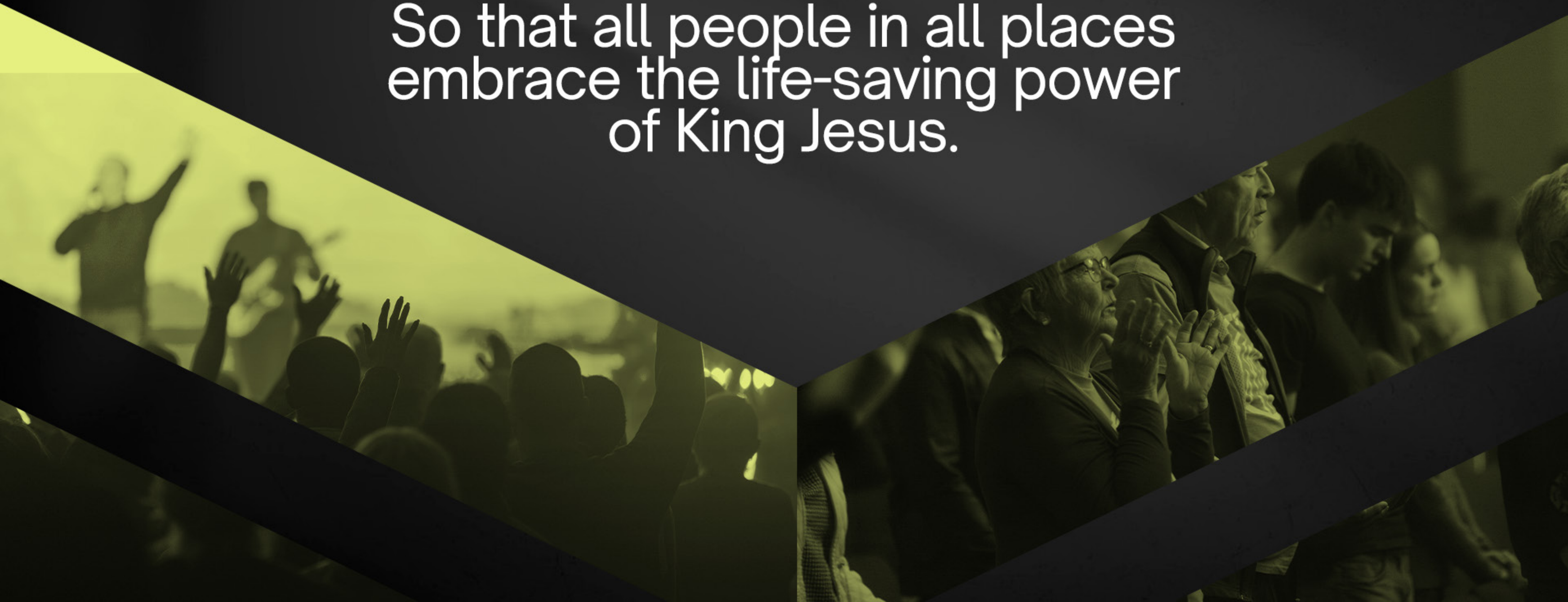

# By the Spirit Testimonies

Over the last year, our team has reported and captured over 120 testimonies, from across all our locations, of God's hand at work. We've heard so many incredible stories of spiritual hunger, divine appointments, salvation, healing, reconciliation, provision, transformation, and more!

After losing his father to drowning, a man developed a severe phobia of water. Stepping into the baptismal tank, he was visibly trembling, yet chose to be baptized. In that moment, he experienced the joy of the Lord as he faced and overcame his fear, saying it had been a long time coming.

With an injured knee, a young man came forward asking for prayer. The team prayed for him and asked him to test the healing he had received. He was completely healed and pain-free, and in complete awe of what God had done for him!

“

A woman from a traditional church background began searching for more of Jesus. She started reading her Bible and came to Kings to be baptized. Her group of seven friends were skeptical when they first heard this, but they surprised her by showing up. During the service, God moved powerfully, and four of her friends gave their lives to Christ, then afterward the whole group asked for prayer.

During a time of prayer, a call was given for those with neck pain. A man hesitated at first but came forward for prayer after living with neck pain for 15 years. He has now been completely pain free for months!

A man returned from a work trip with a severe full-body rash and blisters on his feet. His wife felt led to pray over him. By the next morning, he was completely healed! The rash, the blisters, and every symptom were gone, including a previous illness he had been dealing with from before the trip.

During a Revival service, a woman came forward for prayer who had suffered from severe sleep issues for over 20 years due to trauma. God healed her and dozens of others struggling to find rest over the course of the weekend.

Seven months sober from a 20 year Marijuana addiction, in control of my anger, walking in freedom from my PTSD, depression and self worth, and closer to God than I've ever been! Being in Step Study has given me the safe space of empowerment I didn't know could exist. I have found God & my worth, & I have learned how to put love in place of anger while still making myself a priority. I am never alone because He is an amazing Father.

While the struggles and temptations of the world still arise, I now have confidence that with pause, prayer and giving it to God, any obstacle can be overcome. 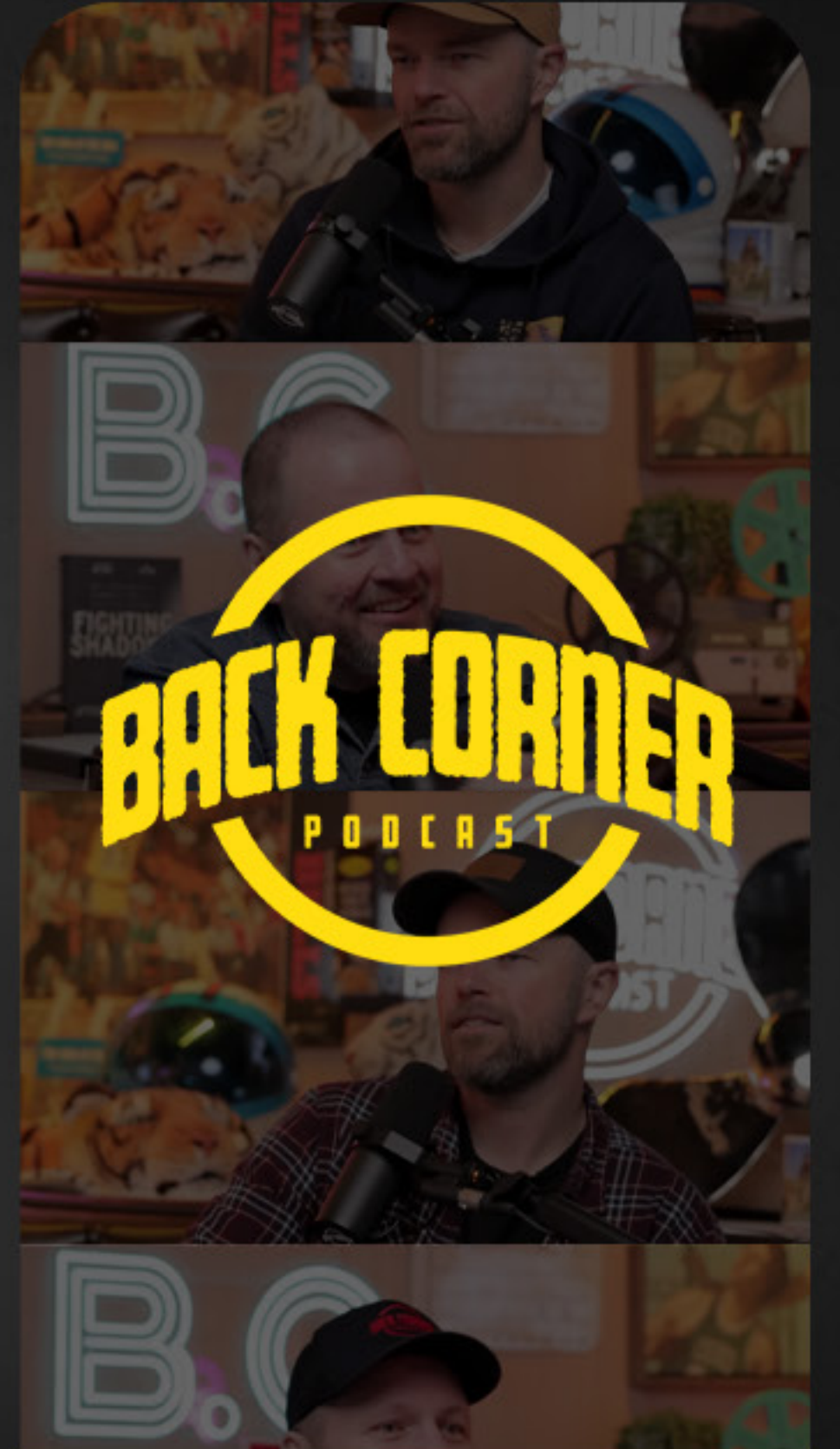
