

DAILY PRAYER PUSH GUIDE

WEEK 1: RELATIONSHIPS

Monday, June 3 – FAMILY

Prayer Points:

- Pray that the Lord would bless and strengthen families.
- Pray that mothers and fathers would grow spiritually and lead their families with wisdom, patience, and discernment.
- Pray for sibling bonds to be strengthened with love, forgiveness, and understanding.

“Do not provoke your children to anger by the way you treat them. Rather, bring them up with the discipline and instruction that comes from the Lord.” (Ephesians 6:4, NLT)

Tuesday, June 4 – RECONCILIATION

Prayer Points:

- Pray for an awareness of any hurts or wrongs you have caused, and for the humility and courage to seek forgiveness.
- Pray for the healing of wounds you have inflicted on others, that God's grace may bring comfort and restoration.
- Pray for the strength to offer the gift of forgiveness to others, to let go of bitterness and resentment, and to experience the healing that Christ offers.

“If you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother or sister has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift.” (Matthew 5:23-24, NIV)

Wednesday, June 5 – MARRIAGES

Prayer Points:

- Pray that marriages would be built on a foundation of genuine love that reflects the sacrificial love Christ has for His Church.
- Pray for open communication between spouses, that they may listen to each other with empathy, speak with kindness and respect, and seek to understand each other's perspectives.
- Pray for spiritual growth and alignment in marriage, that spouses may grow together in their relationship with God.

“Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her...” (Ephesians 5:25, NIV)

Thursday, June 6 – CHILDREN

Prayer Points:

- Pray for the spiritual formation and growth of children, that they may come to know God's love and grace, and that they may develop a deep and lasting faith in Him.
- Pray for the family ministries of the church, that they will partner with parents, give children a Biblical foundation, and provide them with opportunities to encounter Jesus.
- Pray that God would work through children to reach and bless families with the hope of Jesus.

“Let the little children come to Me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these.” (Matthew 19:14, NIV)

Friday, June 7 – GEN Z

Prayer Points:

- Pray for spiritual growth and maturity among teens and young adults, that they may be rooted in His Word and empowered by the Holy Spirit.
- Amidst the challenges and pressures of adolescence and young adulthood, pray that Gen Z would discover their identity and purpose in Christ.
- Pray for Gen Z to navigate societal influences and pressures with wisdom and discernment, standing firm in their faith and values despite shifting cultural norms.

“Don’t let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity.” (1 Timothy 4:12, NIV)

Saturday, June 8 – RECOVERY

Prayer Points:

- Pray for freedom from bondage, that those struggling with addiction may find healing and deliverance through the power of Christ.
- Pray for victory over the hurts, habits, and hang-ups that hold people back from the life God intends.
- Pray for the friends and family members providing support for those seeking recovery, that they may be encouraged and strengthened themselves.

“Two people are better off than one, for they can help each other succeed. If one person falls, the other can reach out and help.” (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10, NLT)

Sunday, June 9 – GRIEF

Prayer Points:

- Pray for God's comforting presence to surround those who are grieving, knowing that He is faithful to walk alongside us in our darkest moments.
- Pray for faith and trust in God's goodness and sovereignty, even in the midst of grief and unanswered questions.
- Pray for the Holy Spirit to be the ultimate Comforter to those who are grieving, bringing the peace that surpasses understanding and the hope that endures forever.

"The Lord is close to the brokenhearted; He rescues those whose spirits are crushed." (Psalm 34:18, NLT)

WEEK 2: SOCIETY

Monday, June 10 – GOVERNMENT

Prayer Points:

- Pray that our civic, provincial, and national leaders would know Jesus personally and have a vibrant relationship with Him.
- Pray that God would surround our leaders with godly influencers, in the same way He positioned Daniel and Esther to influence the rulers of their day.
- From politics to the workplace, pray that God will bless all those who hold authority over us and equip them with compassion, wisdom, and courage.

"Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity." (1 Timothy 2:2, NLT)

Tuesday, June 11 – MENTAL HEALTH

Prayer Points:

- Pray for those coping with mental health challenges, that they may experience the hope and peace that Christ offers.
- Pray for an increased awareness and compassion regarding mental health issues, that we can more effectively pray, support, and minister to those struggling with mental health issues.
- Pray for effective counselling and support ministries within the Church, providing tools and resources for those in need.

"Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that He may lift you up in due time. Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you." (1 Peter 5:6-7, NIV)

Wednesday, June 12 – EDUCATION

Prayer Points:

- Pray for radical Kingdom transformation of our education systems.
- Pray that those who serve within our school systems (superintendents, board members, principals, teachers, counsellors, aides, etc.) would have a fresh encounter with the life-changing love of Jesus.
- Pray that the next generation would grow in wisdom, knowledge, and favour with both God and people.

“Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it.” (Proverbs 22:6, NIV)

Thursday, June 13 – POVERTY

Prayer Points:

- Pray for innovative ideas and resourcefulness within the Church as we seek practical ways to express the love and compassion of Jesus toward those living in desperate situations.
- Pray for effective strategies to address homelessness and provide support and shelter for those in need.
- Pray for an end to the problem of poverty in our region.

“Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, when it is in your power to act.” (Proverbs 3:27, NIV)

Friday, June 14 – ARTS AND ENTERTAINMENT

Prayer Points:

- Pray for an explosion of creativity that demonstrates the Good News of Jesus, so that culture would be transformed through God-inspired creativity.
- Pray for an influx of Holy Spirit-filled songwriters, storytellers, painters, dancers, and filmmakers.
- Pray for creativity and innovation in ministry, that the Church may adapt to changing times and find new ways to share the Gospel and disciple believers.

“Sing to Him a new song; play skillfully, and shout for joy.” (Psalm 33:3, NIV)

Saturday, June 15 – MEDIA

Prayer Points:

- Pray for honesty, integrity, and responsibility in media reporting and storytelling.
- Pray for open doors for Holy Spirit-filled reformers within the media, that Jesus would be exalted through industry like never before.
- Pray for wisdom in navigating the use of technology and media within the Church; may we use these tools to spread the Gospel and build community, while guarding against negative influences.

"Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—His good, pleasing and perfect will." (Romans 12:2, NIV)

Sunday, June 16 – SOCIAL JUSTICE

Prayer Points:

- Pray for hearts of compassion and mercy to abound, that we may be a voice for the marginalized, the oppressed, and the vulnerable, just as Jesus was during His earthly ministry.
- Pray for an end to all forms of exploitation and injustice—such as human trafficking, slavery, domestic violence, systemic racism, and gender inequality—that every individual may live in freedom and dignity.
- Pray that God's will would be done on earth as in heaven.

"Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute. Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy." (Proverbs 31:8-9, NIV)

WEEK 3: THE CHURCH

Monday, June 17 – THE LOCAL CHURCH

Prayer Points:

- Pray for discernment and wisdom in navigating cultural trends and societal challenges, that we may remain faithful to God's Word and mission.
- Pray that, more and more, the church would be set apart for God's glory and empowered by the Holy Spirit to accomplish God's purposes.
- Pray for an increased desire to know Jesus and a fresh hunger for the Word of God.

"Together, we are His house, built on the foundation of the apostles and the prophets. And the cornerstone is Christ Jesus Himself. We are carefully joined together in Him, becoming a holy temple for the Lord." (Ephesians 2:20-21, NLT)

Tuesday, June 18 – WORSHIP

Prayer Points:

- Pray that the Church would grow as a community of worshippers, collectively seeking to honour and glorify the Lord.
- Pray that we would experience deeper levels of intimacy and connection with God through worship.
- Pray that our worship would be a powerful witness that draws others to God.

“Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.” (Colossians 3:16, NIV)

Wednesday, June 19 – CHURCH LEADERSHIP

Prayer Points:

- Pray for wisdom, humility, and discernment for those in positions of leadership within the Church, that they may be faithful servants of Christ as they shepherd and lead His people.
- Pray for our leaders to grow in intimacy with Christ, that they may lead with integrity, purity, and godliness.
- Pray that our leaders and their families would be strengthened and empowered to stand firm amidst the challenges of ministry life.

“Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the Church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. Their responsibility is to equip God’s people to do His work and build up the Church, the Body of Christ.” (Ephesians 4:11-12, NLT)

Thursday, June 20 – PRAYER

Prayer Points:

- Pray for the development of a strong culture of prayer within the church, where seeking God through prayer is prioritized in every aspect of ministry and community life.
- Pray for God to instill a deep passion for prayer within the heart of every church member, making prayer a central and integral part of our lives.
- Pray that the church becomes known for its intercession, consistently contending for the needs of others in Jesus’ name.

“Their burnt offerings and sacrifices will be accepted on My altar; for My house will be called a house of prayer for all nations.” (Isaiah 56:7, NIV)

Friday, June 21 — REPENTANCE

Prayer Points:

- Pray for a spirit of repentance and humility within the broader Church, leading to personal and collective renewal and revival.
- Pray for healing of racial and cultural divides within the Church, acknowledging times we have fallen short of God's standards, that we may be unified as one Body.
- Seek forgiveness for the times Christians has unjustly caused hurt and resentment by failing to speak and act with the love of Christ, even claiming the name of Jesus in the process.

"If My people, who are called by My name, will humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land." (2 Chronicles 7:14, NIV)

Saturday, June 22 — STEWARDSHIP

Prayer Points:

- Pray for wisdom and generosity in financial stewardship within the Church, that resources may be used wisely for God's Kingdom purposes.
- Pray that Kingdom resources may be multiplied, unlocking more opportunities for ministry in the name of Jesus.
- Pray for responsible stewardship in all areas of life, that God may be glorified in how we live.

"When someone has been given much, much will be required in return; and when someone has been entrusted with much, even more will be required." (Luke 12:48, NLT)

Sunday, June 23 — SPIRITUAL GROWTH

Prayer Points:

- Pray for spiritual growth and maturity within the Church as believers, deepen in their relationships with Christ, practice spiritual habits and disciplines, and become disciples who make disciples.
- Pray for the transformation of hearts and minds by the power of the Holy Spirit, that we may be renewed in righteousness and become representatives of God's love and justice in the world.
- Pray that the Fruit of the Spirit (love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control) would grow and be evident in the lives of all believers.

"So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. And the Lord—who is the Spirit—makes us more and more like Him as we are changed into His glorious image." (2 Corinthians 3:18, NLT)

WEEK 4: ON EARTH AS IN HEAVEN

Monday, June 24 – UNITY

Prayer Points:

- Pray for a unity that transcends the cultural, generational, and socioeconomic diversity among believers, demonstrating the oneness Christ desires for His Church.
- Pray for genuine Christian community within the Church, where members bear one another's burdens and celebrate one another's joys.
- Pray for unity and cooperation among Christians across different churches, denominations, and traditions—across our region and beyond—that we may be one, to the glory of God.

“May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that You sent Me and that You love them as much as You love Me.” (John 17:23, NLT)

Tuesday, June 25 – SIGNS & WONDERS

Prayer Points:

- Pray for healings, miracles, and other supernatural manifestations of the Holy Spirit to demonstrate God's glory and reveal His power and love.
- Pray for open hearts and minds to expect signs and wonders from God, and to trust God to respond according to His goodness and grace.
- Pray that signs and wonders will point the lost and oppressed toward Jesus.

“And God confirmed the message by giving signs and wonders and various miracles and gifts of the Holy Spirit whenever He chose.” (Hebrews 2:4, NLT)

Wednesday, June 26 – EVANGELISM

Prayer Points:

- Pray for the Church to be a beacon in our communities, actively reaching out and shining the light of Jesus.
- Pray for “wayward children” who are far from God to be drawn back to faith.
- Ask God to fill you personally with a boldness and passion to share the message of Jesus with others.

“So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making His appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, ‘Come back to God!’” (2 Corinthians 5:20, NLT)

Thursday, June 27 – ALL NATIONS

Prayer Points:

- Pray for missionaries and organizations who are taking the news about Jesus Christ around the world.
- Pray for boldness and effectiveness in sharing the Gospel message, reaching those who have not yet heard or responded to the message of Jesus.
- Pray that we will welcome refugees and immigrants, showing hospitality and extending the compassion of Christ.

“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” (Acts 1:8, NIV)

Friday, June 28 – PERSECUTED CHURCH

Prayer Points:

- Pray for strength, protection, and perseverance for believers facing persecution around the world, and for their faithful witness in the midst of adversity to bring glory to God.
- Pray for comfort and encouragement for persecuted Christians, that they may experience the comforting presence of the Holy Spirit and receive encouragement from fellow believers.
- Pray that the light of Jesus would shine brightly, that many would come to faith in Jesus through the witness of those willing to suffer for the cause of Christ.

“Ask God to give me the right words so I can boldly explain God’s mysterious plan that the Good News is for Jews and Gentiles alike. I am in chains now, still preaching this message as God’s ambassador. So pray that I will keep on speaking boldly for Him, as I should.” (Ephesians 6:19-20, NLT)

Saturday, June 29 – HOPE

Prayer Points:

- Pray for hope and encouragement to abound within the Church, that believers may be filled with joy and peace as they trust in God's promises and share His love with others.
- Pray that those who have placed their hope in Jesus would be encouraged and find their strength renewed.
- Pray for an eternal perspective, remembering that our hope is ultimately in Christ and His imminent return.

“But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.” (Isaiah 40:31, NIV)

Sunday, June 30 — HOLY SPIRIT, COME

Prayer Points:

- Pray for hearts to be prepared for the coming of the Holy Spirit, that we may be vessels ready to receive His presence and power.
- Pray for a deep hunger and thirst for more of God's Spirit in our lives, drawing us into a deeper relationship with Him.
- Pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit within our church and region, leading to spiritual awakening and revival across the land.

“May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.” (Romans 15:13, NIV)
