

Letter From Pastor Brent

PSALM 71:14-17

"As for me, I will always have hope; I will praise you more and more."

I've had the privilege of serving as the Senior Pastor of King's Church since 2012, and with each passing year, I've noticed—and noted—that God's goodness, faithfulness, and fruitfulness continue to abound in our midst more each year. Every year, I look back in awe—and 2025 is no exception.

I know I may sound like a broken record, but once again, God's grace abounds. I'm praising Him for the evergrowing evidence that He is not just sustaining His Church, but building it—with increasing power, depth, reach, and glory flowing from His Presence.

This past year has been an extraordinary one in terms of return on investment. Since launching our Sunday service at the French School and Community Centre in January 2023, we've grown from a post-pandemic missionary team into a thriving, self-sustaining church family.

We've seen people come to faith and be baptized—many with no prior church background—through our weekly presence at the school. Our OneNight monthly worship gatherings have united 12 influential PEI churches, with senior leaders regularly sharing the stage—something unprecedented in our region.
